Directed at implementing a shared European approach to micro-credentials for lifelong learning, the #DiCultHerDigitalBadge aims to allow the active participation of the reference communities in DiCultHer activities, recognizing the skills they acquire, for their personal, social, and professional development.

The Badge, an essential part of the #EdVerso protocol, was created with the aim of achieving a shared system for the enhancement of the skills, credits and professionalism acquired in the field of education and culture. It is also part of a process launched on 2 September 2019 in Matera by the #DiCultHer Association together with #LutinX (formerly Lirax), an innovative American company in the Blockchain sector.Since the #DiCultHerDigitalBadge is a tool for certifying participation in the activities promoted by #DiCultHer and its partners, it will be made available exclusively to teachers and students who participate in the various activities.
