Presentation of the fourteen CHALLENGES of the 5th edition of #HackCultura

The weekly appointments that DiCultHer dedicates to the theme of Digital Culture as a factor in the development of the country and Europe for a new European Bauhaus continues. After the restart of the weekly appointment which took place on October the 7th, the seminar of November the 11th will see alternating speakers and technicians of great importance from the world of Italian education, culture and technology.

The fifth #DiCultHer webinar of the 2022-23 series, scheduled for November 11, 2022, from 15:00 to 18:00, is entitled: Presentation of the fourteen CHALLENGES of the 5th edition of #HackCultura-the hackathon of female and male students for cultural ownership.

The 5th edition of # HackCultura2023, the hackathon of students for cultural ownership and taking charge of the cultural heritage of the territories starts from Italy but is open to the participation of the entire New European Bauhaus (NEB)

HackCultura2023 is "challenge" for teachers and students on many themes, all of which are naturally interconnected, to stimulate sensitivity and attention to relevant contemporary issues, fourteen challenges to convey the use and awareness of the value of digital technologies to protect, present and enhance the cultural heritage- tangible and intangible - among the girls and boys of our schools of various levels. A very important challenge is the 13th, the NFT-Art Competition (<https://www.diculther.it/nft-art/>), which bring the students closer to this new world of conceiving art, thanks to the development of blockchain technologies. New this year is the Badge that participants will be able to obtain at the end of each individual seminar.

#DiCultHerDigitalBadge is an essential tool for the certification of #microcredentials deriving from participation in the activities promoted by #DiCultHer: webinars, participation in #HackCultura, the Digital Culture Weeks, the Digital Cultures magazines and more.

Directed at implementing a shared European approach to micro-credentials for lifelong learning, the #DiCultHerDigitalBadge aims to allow the active participation of the reference communities in DiCultHer activities, recognizing the skills they acquire, for their personal, social, and professional development.

The Badge, an essential part of the #EdVerso protocol, was created with the aim of achieving a shared system for the enhancement of the skills, credits and professionalism acquired in the field of education and culture. It is also part of a process launched on 2 September 2019 in Matera by the #DiCultHer Association together with #LutinX (formerly Lirax), an innovative American company in the Blockchain sector. Since the #DiCultHerDigitalBadge is a tool for certifying participation in the activities promoted by #DiCultHer and its partners, it will be made available exclusively to teachers and students who participate in the various activities.
